



SOUTH SUDAN

For all shipments to and from South Sudan (transit cargo included) the shipper or his forwarder is required to issue an ELECTRONIC CARGO TRACKING NOTE (ECTN), also named cargo waiver, in the port of loading. Each Bill of Lading must be covered by at least one ECTN. The ECTN number needs to be shown on each Bill of Lading and Cargo Manifest. Any cargo not covered by a validated ECTN will be blocked for delivery/customs clearance and will raise penalties and/or fines.

For the arrangement following documents and information etc. are required:

- Copy or draft of B/L, correctly dated
- Commercial Invoice, depending on Incoterm to show fob value of the goods, ocean freight amount, insurance etc. separately (if not, freight invoice/statement to be uploaded in addition)
- Export Customs Declaration
- Country of Origin of the goods
- Incoterm description
